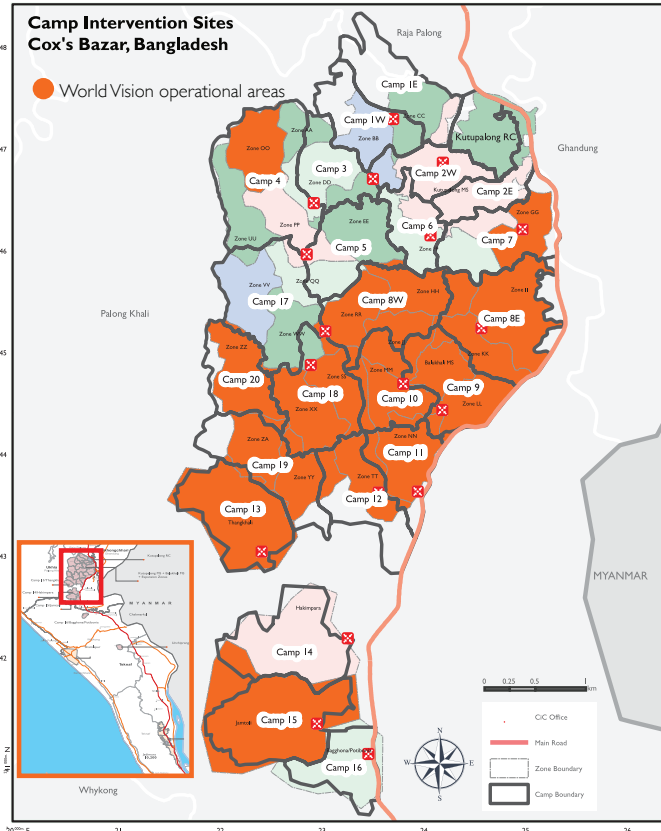

New Priority Sector Focus for 2019



EDUCATION

World Vision will establish **21 new learning centres for adolescents**, collaborating with UNICEF and the inter-agency education to develop instruction materials.



FOOD SECURITY, LIVELIHOODS AND CASH-BASED PROGRAMMING

We plan to **implement skills building and income-generating activities** to build the confidence and resilience of 15,000 Rohingya refugee families and 3,000 **host community** households.



WATER, SANITATION AND HYGIENE

We will develop **community-managed sustainable water networks** and sanitation systems to **improve the living conditions and ensure the dignity** of Rohingya refugees and **host communities**.



NUTRITION

At our proposed multi- purpose centres, women and girls will receive nutrition and GVB-related services. In partnership with WFP, our existing blanket and targeted supplementary feeding programmes will effectively prevent and treat moderate acute malnutrition in children under age 5. We plan to **support more environmentally sustainable solutions**, such as fuel-saving community kitchens featuring cooking demonstrations. More than 33,311 refugees and 8,000 **host community** members will benefit from these initiatives.



CHILD PROTECTION

At our 12 child-friendly spaces, we support families through training on positive parenting skills. Our new awareness campaigns and advocacy will focus on ending violence against children, including child marriage.



GENDER-BASED VIOLENCE PREVENTION

At our new safe space for women and adolescent girls, we will provide psychosocial support and skills training will be provided while sensitizing families, including men and boys, to identify and prevent gender-based violence. More than 60,000 refugees and 5,000 **host community** members will be reached through these initiatives.
